My home is a flat in Berlin in Germany.

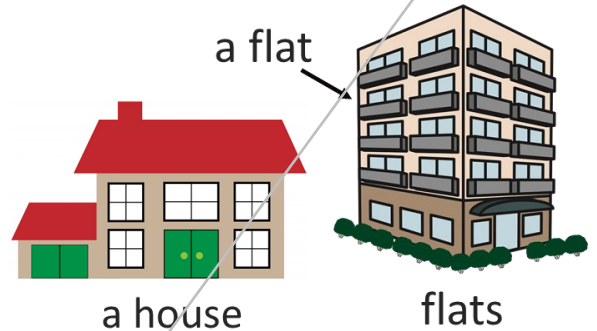
I live on the 5th floor.
